Reporting Home Training Information to an Existing Patient Treatment Record

If a patient initiated training while at your facility, the **Type of Dialysis Training** and the **Dialysis Training Begin Date** are required fields for the patient's treatment Information record.

1. From the Patient Attributes page, click on Admit/Discharge Summary.
2. Click on Treatment Summary
3. Click on Treatment Start Date
4. Click Edit Treatment
5. Add the type of Dialysis Training and Dialysis Training Start Date; add anticipated Dialysis Training End Date.
6. Review to make sure Dialysis Training Begin Date and Treatment Start Date match
7. Click Submit

Facility Responsibilities: Verify training information for accuracy (including those facilities who batch information)

- Treatment Start Date and Dialysis Training Begin Date must be the same date
 - Use first training day with exchange for PD patients
 - Use first training day using HHD machine for treatment at the clinic for HHD patients
- Do not complete training information if patient trained at another chronic outpatient facility
